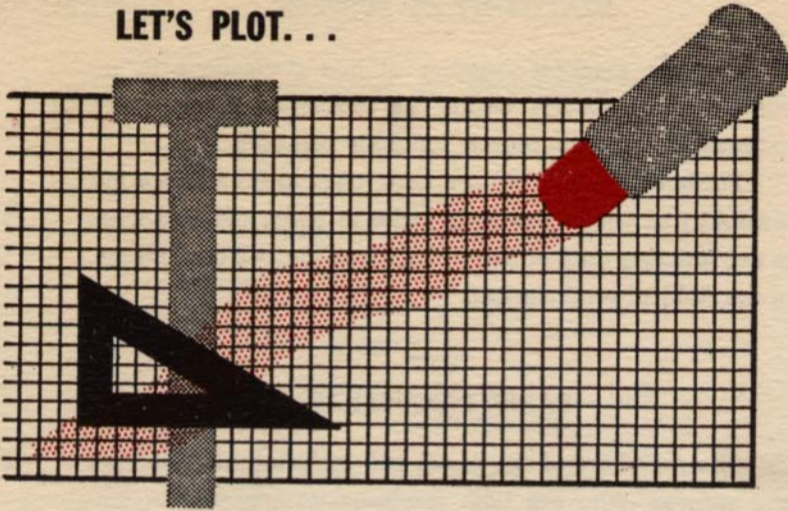

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

We are meeting together at this conference in an effort to more clearly define the problems of women in engineering and to search for their solutions.

Further than this, we are here, also, to investigate the feasibility of joining forces in order to better aid ourselves in our ultimate goal of free acceptance, on our own merits, in the field of engineering.

PANEL DISCUSSION

The members of the panel will include one man and one woman, who are both graduate engineers now employed in the field, to present industry's views on women engineers. From the student point of view we will have one male engineering student from a local college and a Drexel woman engineering student who has been in industry through the Drexel Cooperative Plan of Education.

DR. LILLIAN M. GILBRETH

Guest Speaker

Dr. Gilbreth, "Woman of the Year" in 1948, will be the principal speaker at the conference. A pioneer in the scientific management field, Dr. Gilbreth along with her husband, was an industrial engineer and an expert in motion study. She holds eight honorary degrees, is an author, lecturer, university professor and served on the War Manpower Commission. A current best seller, "Cheaper by the Dozen," is the story of the Gilbreth family as reported by two of Dr. Gilbreth's twelve children.
